
The skin is the largest organ of the human body and protecting skin is an essential element in providing care to well, preterm and sick newborns. The Neo-Skin Special Interest Group provides a forum for discussion of practices that promote neonatal skin health and prevention and management of skin injury for neonates and their families. We also provide opportunities for neonatal nurses to explore and share quality improvement or research initiatives related to skin care and health.

Our focus

Protecting the skin is an essential element in providing care to well, preterm and sick newborns. Furthermore, maintaining skin integrity is a key outcome for the National Safety and Quality Health Service (NSQHS) Standards within Australia. Our focus is reviewing and promoting the best available evidence around neonatal skin injuries and promoting care to meet the key objectives within the NQSHS.

Key areas

- Skin assessment and risk assessment tools
- Management of scalp injuries
- Medical adhesives and related skin injuries
- Dressing or wound choices
- Assessment of skin pigment in skin injuries
- Atopic dermatitis
