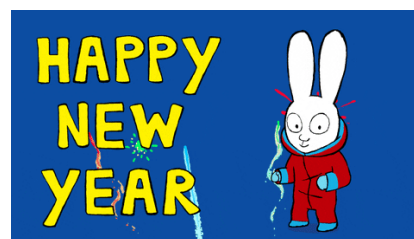


Zoom Teaching Newborn Care Royal Hospital for Women, Sydney, Australia
