Budget:

The allocated SIG budget is to be used as NDC SIG Member scholarships based on the following criteria:

- 6 x \$500 (\$3000) scholarships to be funded and used by 30th June 2019 (we will revise the limit per scholarship after this date)
- Applicants must be current financial members and members of the NDCSIG
- Applicants are required to complete an application form (see attached form we can revise this as directed by the executive)
- Scholarships are used to attend a Neurodevelopmental Care Education Conference or Program, e.g. Fine 1/Fine 2
- Applications are reviewed by three members of the NDC SIG committee.
- Successful applicants are requested to submit a written piece to the ACNN National Newsletter as part of the NDC SIG scholarship requirement.
