ACNN members are invited to apply for the Neonatal Skin Scholarship in the following categories:

1. Course/workshop/conference attendance with a focus on skin/wound care relevant to neonates^{**}
2. Postgraduate study or Higher Degree Research with a specific focus on neonatal skin care aspect[#]
3. Research project or quality improvement initiative with a focus on neonatal skin[#]

Essential criteria

- ACNN member for a minimum of 18 months at time of application and membership current
- Currently working in the neonatal field (e.g. clinically, education, research, academia)
- Currently registered with AHPRA as a nurse or midwife

Application process

1. A one-page cover letter outlining:
 - The scholarship category for which you are applying
 - Response to essential criteria
 - How the scholarship will influence your career in neonatal nursing and contribute to improving neonatal care
 - Names and contact details of two professional referees
2. Current curriculum vitae of no more than two pages
3. Detailed budget with receipts or documentation of total expenses
4. Email the application to Dr Linda Ng at theprofessionallofficer@acnn.org.au. All applications received will be acknowledged by email within 48 hours. If you do not receive an acknowledgement, please resend or contact the Professional Officer.

Scholarship conditions

- [#] Awarding of full expenses is not guaranteed and is at the discretion of the awarding panel
- ^{*} Only registration, travel and/or accommodation expenses are applicable
- Receipts or invoices must be provided to be reimbursed, or alternatively ACNN can expenses directly to provider
- Recipient/s are encouraged to attend the ACNN National Conference to be presented the scholarship
- The recipient is required to write a brief article (around 200 words) for the ACNN newsletter within 1 month of completion or attendance at the conference/course/training.
